POLICY TITLE: Safety, Health and Sanitation

1. In accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws, as well as the State Requirements for Educational Facilities, the President of the School, or a designee of the President, is obligated to develop policies and procedures to address environmental concerns, as well as safety, health, and sanitation requirements (SREF).
2. These guidelines are intended to serve as the School's program of safety, health, and sanitation for the protection of the occupants in School buildings and ancillary plant. In the event of a casualty, the procedures must also include a notification procedure, as well as provisions for required inspections, the removal of any educational or ancillary plant, or any portion thereof, from use until conditions that are unsafe or unsanitary are either corrected or removed, and the withdrawal of use of any plant or portion thereof.
